- The wine cellars of Cricova are the second largest wine cellar in Moldova, after Milestii Mici (the largest in the world).
- It boasts 120 kilometres (75 miles) of labyrinthine roadways, versus MM's 200 kilometres (120 miles).
- Tunnels have existed under Cricova since the 15th century, when limestone was dug out to help build Chişinău.
